Part I:

DUE DATE: Monday, October 10

Assignment: Each student/ pair of students will be assigned one country and will produce a travel tri-fold display with 5 destinations.

Please use tri-fold display board.

Display must contain each of the following:

1. A map of the country

(10PTS.)

- *Each map must include major geographical points of interest mountain ranges, significant rivers, and bordering countries.
- *Identify with a (*) the 5 five destinations with the name of each location.
- 2. The national flag of your assigned country

(10PTS.)

3. Additional pictures (at least five) representing the art, sites of natural beauty, ancient ruins, or other points of interest specific to your country. (5PTS.)

PLEASE BE ARTISTIC AND MAKE YOUR POSTER ASTHETICALLY PLEASING.

The back of each poster must contain each of the following:

1. A short report – 4-5 paragraphs outlining a brief history of your country.

(25PTS.)

Be sure to include: a. HISTORY -the early or native people of the region, date the country was claimed for Spain, date of independence from Spain

- b. Other languages spoken, and the type of government, name of currency used
- c. Typical or national MUSIC and a description, and the national SPORT
- d. FAMOUS people from the country politicians, artists, singers, actors, etc.
- e. FOOD typical foods with descriptions

2. 5 different destinations in your country.

(50PTS.)

The 5 destinations must include at least one city, one historical or ancient site, and one site of natural beauty.

Each destination must include (a.) a description of the location, (b.) important history or point of interest of that location, (c.) other things to do while at that site, (d.) and food, sport, or activity typical of the region.

- 1. You will give a brief class presentation, identifying your country and 2-3 points of particular interest. (What did you find most interesting about your country?) As part of your presentation, you will bring and present sample music, photos, or a video depicting the typical music, costume, or dance of your country. (25 PTS.)
